POSITION SUMMARY:

In this role, you will oversee and coordinate utility construction projects, ensuring work is completed safely, efficiently, and in compliance with company standards and project specifications. The Utility Foreman is responsible for supervising crews in the installation, maintenance, and repair of water, sewer, storm, and other underground utility systems while maintaining a strong focus on safety, quality, and productivity.
